2011 Spring-seeded grains and oilseeds

How to participate

1. Insure all your spring-seeded grain and oilseed acres in each of the following crop plans:
 - black beans
 - white beans
 - cranberry beans
 - kidney beans
 - Japan/other beans
 - canola
 - corn
 - organic corn
 - popping corn
 - mustard
 - peanuts
 - soybeans
 - spring wheat
 - spring grain
 - sunflowers
2. Follow good farm management practices and report crop damage immediately.
3. Meet all deadlines in the following table.
4. Pay your premium by the deadline shown when you get your invoice.

Planting deadlines

Planting deadlines have been established for various specifically defined geographical areas. The final planting date is the last day that a crop can be planted and still qualify for insurance coverage.
